BOOK WEEK 16 - 20 November

- Children will be using a variety of books as a focus for their work this week. Mrs Collman has also arranged for the librarian to read stories to the children one day.

- **Friday 20th – Dressing Up Day.** Children and adults are invited to dress up as a character from a book or nursery rhyme for the day.
- **Thursday 26th** – A theatre group is performing the story of Pinocchio for the children.

- **Tuesday 1st December - Tag Day.** Children are able to wear their own clothes for a donation of a new, unused bottle for the Bottle Tombola in the Christmas Fair.
- **Tuesday 1st December – decorating the Christmas tree** in the school hall. Children are able to make a decoration at home and hang it on our tree for a donation of 50p.
- **Wednesday 2nd December, 2.30 – 4.30 – Christmas Fair.** The Fund Raising Group have been busy organising a really exciting Fair which will have a Victorian theme this year. There will be a lot of new stalls as well as some old favourites: e.g. Indian food, a gingerbread stall, bottle tombola, glace chestnuts, guess the weight of the cake and *many, many more*. As usual, we shall be having refreshments including a cake stall and we shall also be selling toys and books. Santa will also be visiting and there will be some games for the children to play whilst they are waiting to see him. We shall also be selling raffle tickets for our Christmas Raffle.
